COMPOSITION: Each liter contains:

AMITRAZ

20 % W/V (A.I.)

PROPERTIES:

VAPCOZIN - 20% : Is an acaricide, insecticide effective against a wide range of mites and insects with low toxicity to mammals.

VAPCOZIN - 20% : Controls all stages of mites (egg, larvae, nymph and adults) which became resistant to other pesticides therefore decrease the number of treatments.

VAPCOZIN - 20% : Special activity against some insect pests such as Whiteflies, Scale insects, Leafminers, Psylla, Aphids, Moth and Mealy bugs.

Citrus.	Two Spotted mite.	10 - 50 ml	When a rate of two pests appear / leaf.	14 days
	Red spidermite.	6 - 50 ml		
	Citrus rust mite.	10 - 50 ml		
Watermelon, Squash.	Two spotted red mite, Two spotted red brown mite.	35 - 50 ml	When symptoms appear repeat spraying when need every two or three weeks .	14 days

CAUTION :

Used only on above mentioned crops and follow the recommended safety period before harvest.

RE-ENTRY PERIOD : 24 hours from last treatment.

COMPATIBILITY: Incompatible with alkaine compounds and parathion.
