

Pyrethroidal Insecticide Emulsifiable Concentrate

COMPOSITION: Each litre contains:

Fenvalerate

200 gm

PROPERTIES:

- Non-systemic insecticide and acaricide with contact and stomach action.
- Controls a wide range of external parasites, including those resistant to other insecticides.
- High insecticidal, ovocidal and larvicidal activity at low dosage.
- It is characterized by low toxicity to mammals.
- Has a powerful antecedent and repellant effects.

USES:

- For the treatment of different forms of mange and for the control of ticks, lice and keds on sheep, goats, cattle and camels.
- It is used to combat flies on cattle, stable flies, and crawling insects in shelters, animals and poultry houses.
- Is sprayed on fly breeding sites to destroy larvae and keep down fly population.

METHODS OF APPLICATIONS:

By spraying or dipping after dilution with water as follows:

For stables, and animals houses	1:100]

PRECAUTIONS:

- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, skin, and inhalation.
- Don't allow off-spring to suckle until mothers are completely dried from the insecticide liquid.
- Don't mix with other insecticides.
- Toxic to bees and fishes.
- Before spraying, wear protective clothes, gloves, boots, and goggles.
- Do not eat, drink or smoke during spraying.
- Avoid polluting ponds waterways and water sources.
- Keep away from children, food and drinks.

ANTIDOTE:

Not specific, treat according to symptoms.

SAFETY PERIOD:

For meat consumption: 2 days.

STORAGE: Keep in a dry, dark place below 30 °C.

PACKING: (1,5, 20) Litres.
