PROPERTIES:

MANTOX : Protective fungicide, highly effective in controlling many fungal diseases on many agricultural crops.

MANTOX : With a broad spectrum action to control fungal diseases and protect from resistant formulation towards other pesticides.

MANTOX : Has a longer protection period than any other fungicides, contains Mancozeb as active ingredient which is needed to the crop growth.

MANTOX : Contains Zinc and Manganese which are needed to crop growth.

USES AND APPLICATION RATE:

CAUTION:

Used only on above mentioned crops and follow the recommended safety period before harvest.

REMARKS:

- Repeat spray every 10 - 14 days or at lower intervals when the growth is heavy.
- Use the prepared spray solution at the same day keep agitation.
- When spray Stone fruits after pruning and before bud flowering to control Plum leaf curl use 100 - 150 gm **MANTOX** /20 lt. water.

PHYTOTOXICITY:

Non-phytotoxic at the recommended rates, except to Carrots and Potatoes under certain conditions. Russetting may occur with some varieties of Apple.

RE-ENTRY PERIOD:

24 hours after the last application.

COMPATIBILITY:

Compatible with most pesticides, except Thiram, Lime sulfur, and Dithiocarbamates.
