



VERMIZOLE – 600

Albendazole Bolus

Anthelmintic for sheep, goats, cattle, calves

COMPOSITION: Each bolus contains:
Albendazole 600 mg

PROPERTIES:

- Albendazole is an anthelmintic (dewormer) that belongs to the group of benzimidazole derivatives and is active against a wide variety of worms and, at higher doses, also against adult liver flukes.

INDICATIONS:

Prophylaxis and treatment of worm infestations in calves, cattle, goats and sheep, such as:
Gastrointestinal worms: Bunostomum spp., Cooperia spp., Chabertia spp., Haemonchus spp., Nematodirus spp., Oesophagostomum spp., Ostertagia spp., Strongyloides spp. and Trichostrongylus spp.
Lungworms: Dictyocaulus viviparus and D. filaria.
Tapeworm: Moniezia spp.
Liver flukes: Adult Fasciola hepatica.

DOSAGE: (Single dose)

For oral administration.

Cattle and calves:

1 bolus per 120 kg body weight.

Liver flukes:

1 bolus per 70 kg body weight.

Goats and sheep:

1 bolus per 70 kg body weight.

Liver flukes:

1 bolus per 60 kg body weight.

WITHDRAWAL PERIOD:

For meat consumption: 12 days.

For milk consumption: 4 days.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Administration during the first 45 days of gestation.

SIDE EFFECTS

Hypersensitivity reactions.

STORAGE: Keep in a dry, dark place below 30 °C.
